FIRST AMENDMENT

TO

AGREEMENT BETWEEN

CITY OF BLOOMINGTON PLANNING AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT AND

MJ WELLS AND ASSOCIATES FOR A

TRAVEL DEMAND MANGEMENT PLAN

(Entered in this 29th day of October, 2019)

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of June 2019, the City of Bloomington Department of Planning and Transportation (the "Department") entered into an agreement ("Agreement") with MJ Wells and Associates ("Consultant") to develop a Travel Demand Management Plan ("Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the Department wishes to expand the scope of services to add services not originally anticipated; and

WHEREAS, as a result of this modification to the original scope of services the compensation amount will be increased by an amount not-to-exceed, Nine Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$9,625.00); and

WHEREAS, the Consultant is in agreement with said modification; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 26 of the Agreement, the Agreement may be modified only by a written amendment signed by both parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

- 1. To amend Article 1. Scope of Services to reflect additional services as described in the Consultant's "Proposal," attached to this Addendum as "Exhibit A—Proposal" and hereby incorporated into "Exhibit A 'Scope of Work'" of the Agreement. The Agreement, including its "Exhibit A 'Scope of Work'" is attached to this Addendum as Exhibit B.
- 2. To amend Article 4. <u>Compensation</u> to incorporate the cost for the additional services added to "Exhibit A 'Scope of Work'". The Department shall pay Consultant for all fees and expenses in an amount up to and not to exceed One Hundred Seven Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Five Dollars (\$107,575).
