Mike,

Here are some facts;

2020 remains consistent with 2019

170 cases total in 2020, compared to 172 in 2019

52.44% increase in the number of crimes committed with a firearm. This is specifically when a perpetrator used the firearm in the commission of a crime. Examples would be aggravated assault where a person was shot and did not die, or if the victim was hit in the head with the gun, threatened or intimidated by a person with a firearm.

41 cases documented where a single and/or multiple guns were listed as stolen and/or recovered as property. There were a total of 77 individual guns.

71 cases documented weapons violations. This would include discharging a firearm within city limits, carrying a handgun without a license, and similar violations.

In 2020, 4 out of 5 homicide cases a firearm was used.

BPD responded to 270 Mental Health CFS in 2020.

I will keep looking for more facts and will send anything else I can find before noon.
