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Today, the Supreme Court stayed the implementation of OSHA's COVID-19 temporary emergency standards. Compliance with these standards was the primary reason for the "Monroe County Vaccine and Testing Requirement Policy as per OSHA Standard". It is the intent of the Commissioners to revisit these rules at next week's meeting. Therefore, department leaders are being asked to not enforce the additional requirements found in that particular policy. Compliance with the local health order and other aspects of the County Continuity of Operations Plan is still expected.
