**ORDER AMENDING ORDER ON PARTIAL SUMMARY JUDGMENT**


This matter came before the Court on the Unopposed Motion to Amend Order on Partial Summary Judgment filed by the Plaintiff, the City of Bloomington (“Bloomington”); and the Court, having considered the same and being duly advised in the premises, hereby finds that Bloomington’s Motion to Amend should be **GRANTED**.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the Court’s Order Granting Partial Summary Judgment dated June 18, 2024, shall be, and hereby is, amended to include the following language pursuant to Rules 54(B) and 56(C) of the Indiana Rules of Trial Procedure and Rule 2(H) of the Indiana Rules of Appellate Procedure:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Indiana Trial Rule 56(C), the Court hereby determines that there is no just reason for delay and hereby directs entry of final judgment as to Counts I, II, and II, as set forth in this Order. The Court,

therefore, directs the Clerk of the Court to enter this judgment as a final judgment in the Judgment Docket as to Counts I, II, and III for all of these consolidated cases.
