
City Council Meeting: July 31, 2019

Bloomington, Indiana Agenda Items: Mapped Out



PUD proposed at Motel 6 location

On the agenda for first reading, likely to be referred to the city council's land use committee, is a zoning change for the Motel 6 property that would allow for construction of a proposed 820-bedroom student housing development on North Walnut at the current Motel 6 site.

OK parking on Dunn; Parking Commish

On the agenda for first reading is a change to parking regulations to allow for street parking on Dunn Street between 6th and 10th streets. Also related to parking is a proposal to make membership criteria on the Parking Commission less restrictive.

Ordinance affecting e-scooters

Several amendments to the proposed regulations affecting e-scooters have been approved previously. Among them is an expansion (blue) of the existing sidewalk dismount zone for bicycles (orange) and its application to e-scooters. On the July 31 agenda are five more amendments. They cover: dismounting while passing peds; availability of helmets; situations where parking on sidewalks is OK; explicit mention of the ADA; and revision of effective date to Sept. 1
