A man carrying a **gun** tucked into a belt under his wet T-shirt was seen at the Bryan Park Pool recently.

I knew that Indiana state law allows citizens to carry their guns pretty much anywhere, but this **pool** is filled with children at play, and a weapon has no place there.

After calling the mayor's office, I learned that the city of Bloomington cannot require that patrons leave their firearms locked in their cars.

Given how easy it is for Indiana residents to evade a background check by buying from a private seller, and that no training is required even from those who do have a permit, how can I feel safe bringing my grandson to the **pool**?
