Rules of Behavior for the Bloomington Community Farmers' Market:

- Signs and distribution of literature at Market by the public are:
 - **Is pP**ermitted beyond the market boundaries
 - North of 8th Street on the B-Line Trail
 - South of 7th Street on the B-Line Trail
 - The sidewalks on 7th St.
 - The sidewalks on Morton St.
 - North of the Market on the small brick plaza near the north entrance to City Hall
 - Is pPermitted within the Market
 - On Plaza oneA on the B-Line Trail unless previously reserved
 - On Info Alley, along 8th St. on the west side of the Market
 - Is nNot permitted on the blacktop area of Showers Common (where farm vendors are set up)
 - Is nNot permitted on the B-Line Trail (other than Plaza oneA)
 - Is nNot permitted on the brick plaza and grass terrace in front of City Hall

These areas are considered free speech areas.

- Signs and distribution of literature at Market by vendors are:
 - Is pPermitted consistent with the Vendor Contract
- Customer and Vendor Interactions:
 - Interruption of commerce is not permitted
 - Except in designated free speech areas, the following conduct is prohibited: picketing, demonstrating, yelling, excessive or unreasonable noise-making, obstructing or hindering the flow of pedestrians or access to a vendor, and other conduct disrupting Market activities Individuals interrupting the Market by yellingor causing a scene is not permitted
 - Market staff will ask any persons causing disruptionviolating these prohibitions to relocate to a free speech area
 - If this is not successful market staff or vendor will contact the Bloomington Police <u>Department (BPD)</u>
 - BPD will reiterate <u>the</u> request to move, <u>and</u> if <u>this is</u> not <u>compliant thissuccessful</u>, <u>will lead to arrest the individual may be subject to arrest</u>.
- Information Alley
 - <u>Anyone wishing to utilize space in Information Alley will be chargedhas</u>_a \$10 one_-time registration fee as<u>nd well as</u> a weekly \$10 fee
