ATTORNEY FEE AFFIDAVIT

David L. Ferguson of Ferguson Law, one of the attorneys for Defendant, 222 Hats, LLC, in the above action, being first duly sworn upon his oath, says:

 I am co-counsel for 222 Hats, LLC in this cause of action. My representation began on or about April 2019.

2. Indiana Rule of Professional Conduct 1.5 provides a non-exclusive guideline for determining the reasonableness of attorneys' fees incurred in this matter.

3. Per Rule 1.5, the following factors should be taken into account in determining the reasonableness of the fees:

- a. The time and labor required by the representation. Up to and including the date hereof, the undersigned law firm and counsel have been required to devote in excess of 100 hours to the representation of 222 Hats, LLC, and it is estimated that the undersigned will have to devote more hours to complete this representation in this cause for 222 Hats, LLC after the date hereof, the approximate total number of hours being impossible to determine at this time. As of the date hereof, the firm, including the undersigned counsel, has performed the following services in its representation herein (this is a summary the complete bills and descriptions are attached as exhibit 2).
 - Correspondence and telephone conferences with primary counsel regarding defense of claims brought against 222 Hats, LLC.
 - ii. Research and revisions to documents, pleadings, memoranda in defense of 222 Hats, LLC.
 - iii. Client conferences and correspondence regarding status of suit and defenses.
 - iv. Discovery disputes, motions, hearings, conferences w. opposing counsel and co-counsel, review of many hundreds of pages of documents produced by Plaintiff in the course of this action.
 - v. Hearing on objections, work on post-hearing findings and

conclusions.

vi. Work on fee petition, preparation for hearing on attorneys' fees

Subsequent to the date hereof, it will be necessary for the undersigned counsel to devote the following time and services in this cause:

- vii. Hearing on fees and preparation of post-hearing memorandum and judgment on the issue of attorneys fees,
- b. The novelty and difficulty of the questions involved. The litigation of this matter has been at times difficult and contentious. Plaintiff has continued to put forth creative and clever arguments in support of their contentions.
- c. The skill requisite to perform the legal service properly. Plaintiff's actions and arguments impacted the amount of fees.
- d. The likelihood, if apparent to the client, that the acceptance of the particular employment will preclude other employment by the lawyer.
- e. The fee customarily charged in the locality for similar legal services. Litigation of municipal condemnation involving large sums of money is appropriately billed on an hourly basis and the fee is directly related to the amount of time spent. It is impossible to estimate the amount of time that will be required at the outset of the litigation. Every case is different as the facts, parties and lawyers are different in each case. The time spent in this case was reasonable and the rate charged reasonable. The stated hourly rate for the undersigned's time was \$275 per hour but the average rate for the firm's bill works out to be less per hour when all lawyers' time, no charge entries and support staff time is considered.
- f. The amount involved. Plaintiff sued 222 Hats, LLC to take Defendant's property. According to Plaintiff, the property is valued in excess of \$500,000. Defendant contends the property is worth more than Plaintiff contends.
- g. The results obtained. 222 Hats, LLC was successful in that Plaintiff was not permitted to take Defendant's property.
- h. The time limitations imposed by the client or by the circumstances. As with any litigation of this value and importance to the client, it took precedence over other cases and legal matters for the firm, limiting the time counsel and staff could spend on other matters.
- The nature and length of the professional relationship with the client.
 Undersigned counsel has represented Juan Carrasquel, the principal of 222 Hats, on other matters.
- j. The experience, reputation and ability of the lawyer or lawyers performing the services. The undersigned was admitted to practice law in the State of Indiana in 1981 and I have, since 1981, continuously practiced law in Monroe County, Indiana in affiliation with the law firm of Ferguson Law (formerly Ferguson & Ferguson and Ferguson, Ferguson & Lloyd). My practice has been primarily in the state and federal (Southern District) courts of Indiana. I have represented clients in approximately 54 different counties in Indiana but practice primarily in Monroe and the surrounding

counties. I have participated as lead counsel or second chair in 23 jury trials and many bench trials. I have handled either as lead counsel or assisted approximately 28 appeals and participated in two oral arguments in front of the Indiana Court of Appeals. I attach a summary resume as Exhibit 1 which accurately summarizes my experience. A substantial portion of the undersigned counsel's practice is devoted to litigation such as this matter.

- k. Whether the fee is fixed or contingent. This fee has been hourly, and not contingent, to date.
- 4. That the necessary legal associates, clerks, and secretarial services employed by the undersigned, in addition to the office equipment and research resources used by counsel are factors that should be taken into consideration in setting the fee.
- 5. That the fee set forth below is the customary and usual fee for like and similar cases representing litigants in Monroe County, Indiana.
- 6. That based on all of the above, a reasonable fee in this cause of action for the firm of Ferguson Law only, from April 2019 through January 21, 2020, is \$22,848.25. This is exclusive of expenses and costs advanced on behalf of 222 Hats, LLC, which total \$0. The total of fees and costs to date is \$22,848.25.
- A detailed copy of the firm's time entries, with a fee summary, is attached hereto as Exhibit 2.
- 8. Attorney Amanda Stephens assisted in the representing 222 Hats, LLC in this matter. Stephens joined Ferguson Law in August 2018 and left in June 2019.
