

Section 4. Transportation for the Convention Center: The City and County agree that a successful project will require adequate transportation options for all users to access the Convention Center site. The City and County agree that in line with their mutual sustainability and climate-change goals and commitments, every effort shall be made to reduce demand for parking and single-occupancy vehicle trips. This shall be accomplished through the rigorous exploration and pursuit of transportation demand management (TDM) strategies, to be coordinated between the City and CIB.

These demand-reduction measures may include, but are not limited to: (a) fare-free shuttle service to and from the Indianapolis airport, as well as to and from local parking facilities; and (b) management as a common pool of any structured parking in the Project Hotel, the 4th St. parking garage, and the 2nd St. IU Health parking garage (to be transferred to the City in 2021), all of which shall be available to Convention Center attendees. The total cost of ownership of any publicly owned, structured parking (including debt service, operations, and maintenance), shall be paid for solely through revenues and not through tax dollars.
