## STATEMENT FROM ATTORNEY KATHARINE LEILL AND HER CLIENT VAUHXX BOOKER

We are encouraged that the DNR (Department of Natural Resources) has delivered their investigative file to the Monroe County Prosecutor's office. The file contains information on their investigation into the July 4<sup>th</sup> attack and attempted lynching of Vauhxx Booker. Of course we would rather they had saved Mr. Booker and the Bloomington community these past two weeks of pain and suffering by having arrested those individuals responsible on the night of the assault.

We want to be confident that Monroe County Prosecutor Erika Oliphant will act swiftly and do the right thing by issuing arrest warrants for these individuals so that they can be held accountable by the legal system.

The unnecessarily drawn out investigation caused stress on Mr. Booker and the people and friends who came to his aide that evening.

We look forward to the conclusions of the FBI investigation into this hate crime and encourage The United States Attorney General for the Southern District of Indiana to convene a grand jury into this incident.

Sadly racist fueled acts like the one Mr. Booker gratefully survived have ended more tragically in other places in our country. Bringing federal Hate Crime charges against these individuals, prosecuting them on the federal level will send a nationwide message that reoccurring acts of hatred and aggression against Black people across the country will not be tolerated and those who perpetrate them will be held accountable to the fullest extent of the law.
