You are hereby notified that on this date the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") has caused the following entry to be made:

On September 13, 2021, the Indiana Office of Utility Consumer Counselor, Washington Township Water Authority, and Trustees of Indiana University on Behalf of its Bloomington Campus (collectively, "Consumer Parties") filed their Joint Notice of Settlement Among Less than All the Parties and Request for Attorneys' Conference ("Notice") in the above-captioned Cause. In the Notice, the Consumer Parties indicated that they reached an agreement in principle on terms that resolve all issues between and among themselves, but which were not agreed to by City of Bloomington, Indiana ("Petitioner"). The Consumer Parties stated that they were continuing to work with Petitioner to reach a global settlement of all issues between and among all parties to this proceeding. On September 14, 2021, Petitioner filed its Response in Opposition to the Notice. On September 15, 2021, the Consumer Parties filed their Joint Reply to Petitioner's Response.

On September 20, 2021, counsel for Petitioner emailed the parties and the Presiding Administrative Law Judge advising that all parties had reached a global settlement in principle and inquiring what dates the Commission had available for a Settlement Hearing.

Based on agreement of the parties, the Presiding Officers inform the parties and other interested individuals that the procedural schedule in this proceeding is modified as follows:

- 1. The parties shall file their Stipulation and Settlement Agreement and respective supporting settlement testimony and attachments on or before October 6, 2021. Copies of same shall be served upon all parties of record.
- 2. The evidentiary hearing previously scheduled to commence on September 27, 2021, is now continued to Friday, October 22, 2021, at 1:30 p.m. in Hearing Room 222 of the PNC Center, 101 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana.

3. All other dates and procedures concerning the procedural schedule as established by the May 18, 2021 Docket Entry in this Cause remain unchanged.
