Event: Winter Storm Warning

Alert:

...WINTER STORM WARNING REMAINS IN EFFECT UNTIL 1 PM EST FRIDAY...

* WHAT...Heavy snow and dangerous cold. Total snow accumulations of 2 to 4 inches. Winds gusting as high as 50 mph. Near blizzard-like conditions possible at times.

* WHERE...Portions of central, south central, southeast and southwest Indiana.

* WHEN...From 4 PM this afternoon to 1 PM EST Friday.

* IMPACTS...Plan on slippery road conditions. Widespread blowing snow could significantly reduce visibility. The hazardous conditions could impact the morning or evening commute. Gusty winds could bring down tree branches and cause power outages. Wind chills as low as 30 below zero will cause frostbite and hypothermia even if outside for only a short time.

* ADDITIONAL DETAILS...A flash freeze is likely this evening as temperatures drop very rapidly while precipitation is ongoing and roads are wet. This will cause significant travel difficulty.

Instructions: If you must travel, keep an extra flashlight, food, and water in your vehicle in case of an emergency. The latest road conditions for Indiana can be obtained by calling 1 800 2 6 1 7 6 2 3
