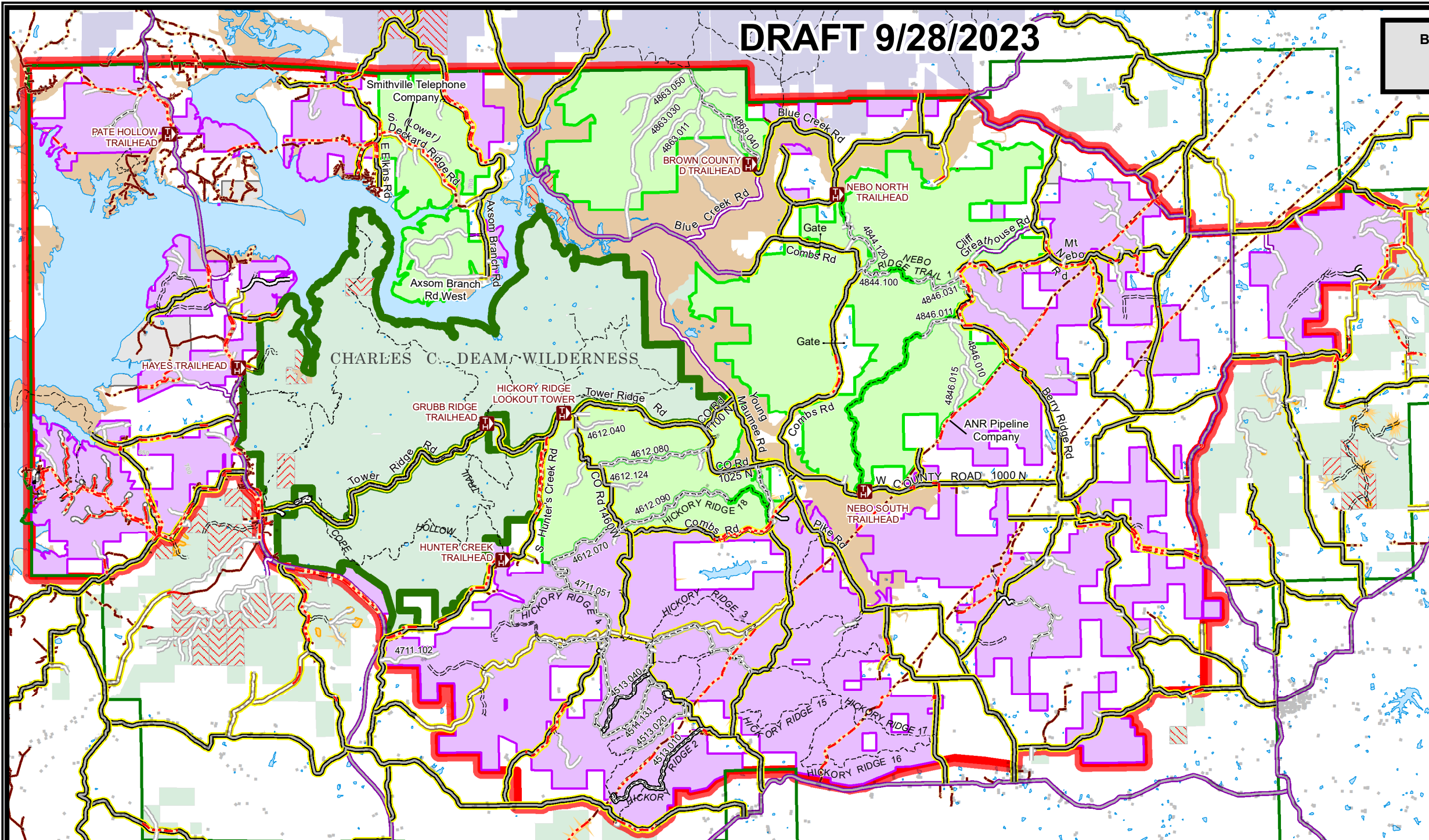

A section of Combs Road is currently (as of September 2023) gated and closed to motorized vehicles but remains open as a trail.

The proposed Wilderness expansion area excludes a 100 ft. setback from centerline of roads and trails listed in the table below.
