Ordinance No. 17-10: South-West B Bloomington Annexation

Dear Property Owner:

As you may know, the City of Bloomington is in the process of considering several areas for annexation, which are identified on the map enclosed as Exhibit A.^{*} The Bloomington Common Council has now introduced Ordinances for the proposed annexations. This letter is to inform you that the City will hold a public hearing on May 31, 2017, at 12:00 p.m. (noon) local time, at Bloomington High School South (purple gym), 1965 S. Walnut Street, Bloomington, Indiana 47401, regarding the proposed annexations. This notice is being provided to you because, according to property tax records, you are a landowner in the proposed “South-West B Bloomington Annexation Area” identified on the enclosed maps. Please note that you may receive multiple notices if you own more than one property in the annexation areas.

For your convenience, we have enclosed the following exhibits:

- Exhibit A A map showing the current and proposed municipal boundaries of Bloomington with all of the currently proposed annexations;
- Exhibit B A map showing the boundaries of the South-West B Bloomington Annexation Area;
- Exhibit C The legal description of the South-West B Bloomington Annexation Area;
- Exhibit D A map showing the current zoning classifications within the South-West B Bloomington Annexation Area. No changes to
