

- Schools lose \$50,000
- City website says, "Areas annexed into Bloomington receive enhanced services including... trash and recycling curbside collection, street and sidewalk/path construction and maintenance..."

but in a phone conversation on August 27, 2021, City Attorney Mike Rooker told my neighborhood's property manager, Carole Damon of Capital Realty, "the City would not take in the streets in Brentwood. If they do provide trash services, you will have to sign a waiver of liability if they damage the streets." This means in addition to the higher property taxes, we will have to pay for road maintenance and repair, snow removal, and trash service.

- Will be served by the same township fire department
- BPD is already understaffed. In September 2023, budgeted for 105 officers but only has 84. How will they serve 14,000 more residents?
- Mayor already raised Income Tax that I do pay into as an MCCSC employee
- Taxes will increase by \$872, but I will not benefit from any additional services.
- I do not use City parks.
